

## **Information on Parking Disc & ID Badge**

#### **Parking Disc**

The Irish Wheelchair Association has advised that for a parking disc, you need to have a primary medical certificate. This is found at your local health office and a medical officer would visit your home to assess your child. If this is approved, you need to request an application form for a parking disc through the Irish Wheelchair Association. When you get this form, complete this form and send it back with the Primary Medical Certificate to the Senior Medical Officer at your local health office. The application form must be completed and certified by your doctor and must be countersigned by a Garda. Decision makers within the issuing authorities will determine if you are eligible based on the information provided.

#### **Local Health Office**

#### **For an Identity Badge**

You would need to get a report from your GP and local Occupational Therapist recommending this ID badge for your child. I would contact your local health office to determine if these reports need to be sent to them.
